### Declaration of Conformity

Herewith we confirm that the products of the NIEDAX Group are in accordance with the following directives:

- 2002/95/EC Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)
- 2003/11/EC Restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances and preparations (pentabromodiphenyl ether, octabromodiphenyl ether)
- 2000/53/EC End Of Life Vehicles

Directive 2002/96/EC (waste electrical and electronic equipment - WEEE) it's not relevant for our products.

The Kleinhuis Product group Surge-Protection-Devices does not apply to directive 2002/95/EC; they are an inherent part of the building installation. We still take pains to change single components inside our Surge-Protection-Devices in consideration of previous quality and safety standards to make them RoHS-conform. For this we must first analyze the long-term behaviour of the new production process.

In accordance to EC-Directive 76/769/EC (Restrictions on the marketing and use of certain dangerous substances and preparations) the products of the NIEDAX Group does not contain any Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAH)

This Declaration of Conformity was prepared according to our present standard of knowledge and may be amended if new cognitions are available and applies only for standard catalog products. For all custom-made special products a separate consultation is obligatory.
